A discussion, led by Paula Burgoyne, explained the responsibilities of the council. We approve Trust Land plan, including goals and budget. We look at test scores and data to plan for future goals. We approve professional development for teachers. We approve School Improvement Plan.

The goals and budget will be posted to be viewed by parents. Goals will be on the school website, along with the minutes from meetings. This year, we have approximately \$37,000 dollars to be spent on 1) Take home librarian 2) Orchestra Instruction 3) Computer Website and Instruction 4) Imagine Learning Language Software Acquisition 5) School Choir 6) Non-fiction library books 7) Supplies.

We looked at the Reading Achievement Plan which includes, but not limited to, working on improving the progress of students who are struggling by building small group instruction in each of the sub categories of DIBELS. A motion to approve the Reading Achievement Plan was made by Trish Topham, 2<sup>nd</sup> by Jessica Kaufman.

The meeting concluded with an explanation of Title 1 and the funding. This year district Title 1 funds were cut 20 percent. This translates to zero money for Three Peaks. PTA has been asked to help.
