

Iron K-6 Online Information

Curriculum: Iron K-6 Online will offer a full K-6 curriculum taught by Iron County School District teachers hired specifically for K-6 Online. Students choosing to enroll in this option will receive their content through [Canvas](#) and [Pathblazers](#). Students will be able to work through the curriculum at their own pace, with time scheduled during the school day to meet with teachers online for tutoring or additional support as needed. The curriculum will follow the same scope and sequence as boundary schools to avoid learning gaps when students return to the classroom. Math, science, reading and writing will be taught using [Pathblazers](#). Online teachers will include additional live and recorded online instruction and hands-on activities for math, science, social studies, art, PE, music and computers each week on Canvas as well. Online teachers will be offering a live-online daily check-in with additional social and emotional learning activities. These will be recorded for those that may not be able to attend.

Time Commitment: Students should expect a time commitment comparable to regular school instructional time. This learning time will be a combination of online and physical activity each day. Regular attendance will be monitored and expected. Parents as learning coaches should expect a time commitment of two to three hours of support for K-2 students with less time needed for grades 3-6. Please be aware that students may also need to schedule time to take district and state testing face to face at the beginning, middle, and end of year.

Learning Supports: Online teachers will review progress reports from Pathblazers daily, and will communicate progress in all subjects on Canvas with parents weekly. If additional support or tutoring is needed, teachers will schedule online tutoring sessions with individual students or small groups. Students needing Special Education Services or English Language Support will receive that support through their boundary school during the day.

School Supports Available: Lunch will be available to all students enrolled in K-6 Online. Social and emotional supports will also be available through the online teacher, counselors, and Licensed Clinical Social Workers. Parents will need to contact the school to arrange these supports.

Dual Immersion: Dual Immersion students may attend half a day at their boundary school and receive additional core support online. All Dual immersion students who choose this option will have access to online language learning programs. Dual Immersion students will need to coordinate this with their boundary school and bus schedules.

Progress Reports: Learning will be reported based on the essential standards using Mastery Connect.

Enrollment: Initial enrollment in Iron K-6 Online will take place online through the district website. Parents will be contacted during the week of August 17th -21st and given information explaining the program, requirements, Canvas login and usage, Pathblazers login, etc. Students attending Iron K-6 Online will stay enrolled in their boundary school, but will complete instruction online with the district online teacher. Students will be able to keep their spots at their boundary schools while attending Iron K-6 Online. Students wishing or needing to go online after school begins will need to contact the school secretary, who will then contact the Online Coordinator to enroll them. Parents will be contacted within 2 days of enrollment during the school year and given information explaining the program, requirements, Canvas login and usage, Pathblazers login, etc.

Returning to Boundary School: When a student is ready to return to their boundary school they will need to notify their school at least two days in advance. The online teacher will then be notified and will provide up to

date information on the progress of the student to the student's boundary school teacher. If a student returns to their boundary school after being enrolled in Iron K-6 Online they will not be guaranteed the teacher formally assigned to them, but will be assigned to a teacher with open seats.
