## COUNSELOR CORNER

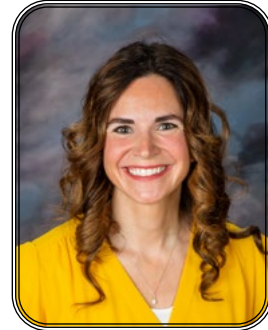

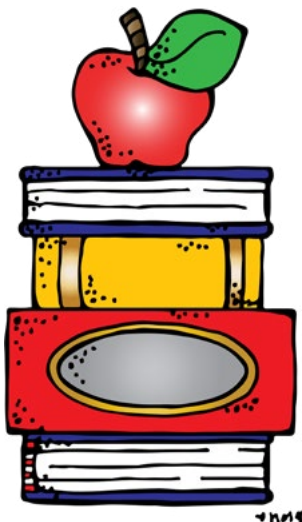
- **A HUGE THANK YOU** to Liz Okeson for the fun **FAMILY WEEK** and all of the PTA Volunteers for this year.
